FLAMMABILITY

QUALIFIED HANDLER: This product must be under the control of an appropriately trained handler during mixing, loading and use.

This product must not be used for any purpose or in any manner contrary to this label unless authorized under appropriate legislation.

RECORD KEEPING: Records of use must be kept when 3 kg or more is applied within 24 hours in a place where Affirm 18 is likely to enter air or water and leave the application area.

PRECAUTIONS

Read label before use. Obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood. Keep away from heat/sparks/open flames/hot surfaces. No smoking.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and inhalation of spray mist. When handling, wear eye protection, waterproof gloves, boots and overalls. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after work. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using. If clothing becomes contaminated with product, remove clothing immediately. Wash protective clothing daily after work.

USE: Apply with well-maintained and calibrated spray equipment.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked, dry, cool area away from foodstuffs, fertilizers and seeds. Avoid storage at temperatures below 5°C and above 35°C. In case of fire use fine water spray or foam. During a fire this product may release smoke and hazardous decomposition products. When fighting a fire wear an air-supplied respirator. Stores containing quantities of more than 100 litres require signage, secondary containment and an emergency response plan. Stores with quantities of 500 litres or more require fire extinguishers. Storage must be accordance with the current version of NZS 8409 Management of Agrichemicals.

DISPOSAL: Avoid contamination of any water supply with chemical or empty container. Container disposal: Triple rinse empty container and add rinsate to the spray tank. Recycle empty rinsed container. Otherwise crush and bury empty container in suitable landfill. Do NOT reuse this container for any other purpose.

Product disposal: Dispose of product only by using according to the label or at an appropriate landfill.

SPILLAGE: Collect spill. Wear suitable protective clothing including face shield, impervious gloves and boots. Prevent product from entering waterways. Eliminate or isolate sources of ignition. Contain liquid spills with absorbent inert material and place in labelled waste containers that can be sealed. Wash area with water and absorbent with further inert material. Dispose of waste safely in a suitable landfill.

FIRST AID

If exposed or concerned, get medical advice. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand. If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth and get immediate medical advice. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get medical advice if irritation persists.
