- Care must be taken around non-absorbent surfaces such as cobblestones, driveways and concrete paths so that runoff does not reach the roots of desirable plants.
- Avoid contamination of any water source with product or empty container.

HOW IT WORKS: Long Term Weedinator is a fast acting knockdown and residual herbicide for total vegetation control in non-cropland areas. Long Term Weedinator will control nearly all annual and perennial weeds and can provide up to 12 months residual activity.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Shake container well before use. Add about half of the water to the spray tank, then add the required amount of product. Mix then add the remaining water. Maintain agitation throughout spraying. Apply in spring or autumn when all weeds are actively growing and while soil is moist. Do not apply under drought conditions. Ensure complete coverage of weeds and bare ground for residual control.

USE	RATE	APPLICATION RATE, TIMING
Non-cropland, e.g. fencelines, paths /driveways, yards	25mL in 1 Litre water	1 Litre spray mix should treat 10 m ² . DO NOT exceed this rate. DO NOT apply more than twice per year.

Equipment Cleaning: It is best practice to use separate equipment for applying herbicides. To avoid injury to subsequently sprayed sensitive crop, thoroughly remove all traces of the product from mixing and spray equipment using several flushes of clean water. Dispose of all washings safely.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice.

STORAGE: Keep out of reach of children. Store in tightly closed original container, locked up in a cool, dry location away from foodstuffs. Shelf life: 2 years from date of manufacture.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of product by using as per label directions or at an approved landfill. Triple rinse empty container adding washings to spray mix. Dispose of the empty rinsed container in the rubbish collection. Do not reuse the container for any other purpose.

SPILLAGE: Collect spillage. Absorb spill with soil or sand and transfer to a labelled sealable container for disposal at an approved landfill.
