- Toxic to bees. Spray must not contact plants in flower while bees are present, or plants likely to flower within two days of application and be visited by bees.
- Do NOT use lawn clippings for compost or mulch for three cuttings after treatment.
- Do NOT plant shrubs or plants in sprayed ground for 6 months after treatment.

HOW IT WORKS: **Lawn Spray Ultra** is a broadleaf herbicide that selectively controls a range of broadleaf weeds in grass lawns. This product does not control grass weeds. **Lawn Spray Ultra** is best applied to actively growing weeds. When weeds are not actively growing, effects may not become noticeable for 3-4 weeks after application.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Shake the container well before use. Add about half of the water to the spray tank, then add the required amount of product. Mix and add the remaining water. It is best practice to use separate equipment for applying herbicides.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply using sprayer or fine rose watering can. Some burning may occur with young and fine turf grasses. It is recommended to do a patch test first and to wait 3-4 months before spraying newly established grass.

USE	WEED	RATE	COMMENTS
Established lawns (at least 3-4 months old)	Control of broadleaf weeds, Onehunga weed and dovers	Use 80mL in 10 litres of water	10L spray for 100 m ² . Apply to actively growing weeds in spring or autumn. Keep children, pets, wildlife and birds off treated lawn until the spray is dry.
Hard to kill broadleaf weeds	Includes convolvulus, docks, sorrel, cape ivy, thistles and buttercups.	120L in 5 litres of water	Apply to actively growing weeds in full leaf. Does not control grass weeds.
Woody scrub	Includes inkweeds, lupin, fennel and broom.	Use 120L in 5 litres of water.	Spray when growth is active from November until March. Add wetting agent for improved coverage.

Trees and tree stumps

Control of willows, poplars, privets and other trees which resprout from stump.

Mix 1 part **Lawn Spray Ultra** with 5 parts water

Paint liberally onto fresh cut stumps or cut a frill around the base of the stump and paint exposed surfaces. It is important to treat around each stem or stump.

EQUIPMENT CLEANING: After application, clean equipment thoroughly with several flushes of water. Dispose of washings carefully.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not breathe spray mist. Wear protective clothing, gloves, eye protection and mask when mixing or using. Do not eat drink or smoke when handling. Wash hands after use and clean protective clothing.

FIRST AID: For advice call a doctor or contact the National Poisons Centre (0800 764 766). If medical advice is needed, have product label or container at hand.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Obtain medical advice if you feel unwell.

STORAGE: Keep out of reach of children and away from foodstuffs. Store in the tightly closed original container, in a cool, dry and secure location. Shelf life 2 years from date of manufacture.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of product by using as per label directions or at an approved landfill. Triple rinse empty container adding washings to spray mix. Dispose of the empty rinsed container in the rubbish collection. Do not reuse the container for any other purpose.

SPILLAGE: Collect spillage. Absorb spill with soil/sand and place in a labelled sealable container for disposal at an approved landfill.
